許善慈善基金的簡介

使命及宗旨——於香港社區推廣中國非物質文化遺產

許善慈善基金有限公司(簡稱:「許善慈善基金」或「許善」),在香港依據公司條例 (第622章)於2019年7月22日註冊成立之非牟利組織,並根據《稅務條例》第88條獲免繳稅之慈善機構(IR91/17085)。

「許善慈善基金」的成立,旨在推廣香港市民認識中國非物質文化遺產,「許善」 會透過教育推廣、活動組織等,在社區裡宣揚中國非物質文化遺產。「許善」尤其 關注青少年人對中國非物質文化遺產的認識和教育,故「許善」負有使命在青少年 群體中,透過多媒體的工具介入,致力推動他們認識中國非物質文化遺產,使香港 社區,尤其是青少年人能夠多認識中國傳統文化和精神,更能承傳下去。與此同時, 「許善慈善基金」亦會關注社會上有需要的群體,如基層居民,天災苦困等,為他 們提供支援和解困,傳揚及延續關愛精神,發放正向能量,彼此建立一個和諧共融 的社區。

「許善慈善基金」主要服務對象:

- a. 學生、幼稚園、小學、中學;
- b. 親子;
- c. 基層家庭;及
- d. 長者。

發揮文化傳遞者的角色

正如上文介紹過「許善慈善基金」的成立的重要目標是在社區裡推廣和教育非物質 文化遺產,希望有更多市民能將這種重要的文化承傳下去。所以,我們尤著重於年 青一代中宣揚中國非物質文化,讓他們從小就多接觸和認識非物質文化遺產,以致 能夠珍惜和延續文化的生命!

「許善」會邀請各社區非政府機構和學校聯合舉辦中國非物質文化遺產工作坊、課程,或活動。同時,「許善」亦會免費提供所需的導師、材料和經費。




發揮社區關愛者的角色

校園以外,「許善」在社區的服務也不遺餘力。過去一年,「許善」與不同的社區中心 及慈善團體合作,多次向有需要人士派發捐贈物質、中秋福袋、冬至福袋、新春福袋、 派飯、派米及防疫用品等等。透過直接施予物質援助,「許善」希望能為市民解燃眉之 急,在關鍵時刻送上一份窩心的暖意。當然,在物質以外,「許善」也十分關注社區內 的精神健康問題。故此,我們在 2022 年 9 月延續了先前與聖雅各福群會在「電話送暖 計劃」中的合作,並進一步去實地探訪不同區域的獨居長者。探訪中,「許善」不但為 長者們送上福袋,更與長者們談天說地、閒話家常。我們在對話中建立起信任,傳遞 「許善」最真切的關愛。

能夠在疫情橫行的日子裡堅持理念,並逐步實踐我們目標,實在有賴背後一群濟世為






「我要做導師」剪紙班 2022年1月



BASIS FOR OPINION

We conducted our audit in accordance with Hong Kong Standards on Auditing ("HKSAs") and with reference to Practice Note 900 (Revised) Audit of Financial Statements Prepared in Accordance with the Small and Medium-sized Entity Financial Reporting Standard issued by the HKICPA. Our responsibilities under those standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the audit of Financial Statements section of our report. We are independent of the Foundation in accordance with the HKICPA's Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants ("the Code"), and we have fulfilled our other responsibilities in accordance with the Code. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our opinion.

OTHER INFORMATION

The directors are responsible for the other information. The other information comprises the information included in the director's report, but does not include the financial statements and our auditor's report thereon. Our opinion on the financial statements does not cover the other information and we do not express any form of assurance conclusion thereon.

In connection with our audit of the financial statements, our responsibility is to read the other information and, in doing so, consider whether the other information is materially inconsistent with the financial statements or our knowledge obtained in the audit or otherwise appears to be materially misstated. If, based on the work we have performed, we conclude that there is a material misstatement of this other information, we are required to report that fact. We have nothing to report in this regard.

REPORTING ENTITY

Xu Shan Charitable Foundation Limited ("the Foundation") is a company incorporated in Hong Kong with limited by guarantee. The principal activities of the Foundation are for providing services on educating the public the general knowledge of various kinds of intangible cultural heritage of the Chinese race on a non-profit making basis and for relief of the needy for the benefit of the Hong Kong community. The address of its registered office is at Suite 702, 7/F., Admiralty Centre Tower One, 18 Harcourt Road, Admiralty, Hong Kong.

Under the provision of the Foundation's articles of association, every member, whilst he is member, or within one year after he ceases to be a member shall, in the event of the Foundation being wound up, contribute such amounts as may be required to meet the liabilities of the Foundation, but not exceeding HK\$100.

1. BASIS OF PREPARATION AND PRINCIPAL POLICIES

The Foundation qualifies under the Companies Ordinance to prepare and present its financial statements in accordance with section 359 of that Ordinance with respect to the Foundation's financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2022.

These financial statements comply with the Small and Medium-sized Entity Financial Reporting Standard issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants and have been prepared under the accrual basis of accounting and on the basis that the Foundation is a going concern.

The measurement base adopted is the historical cost convention.

The following are the specific accounting policies that are necessary for a proper understanding of the financial statements:

a) REVENUE RECOGNITION

Donation revenue is recognized when the donation receipt is issued.

b) TAXATION

Income tax expense represents current tax expenses. The income tax payable represents the amounts expected to be paid to the taxation authority, using the tax rate (and tax law) that have been enacted or substantively enacted by the statement of financial position date.

Deferred tax is not provided.

4. TAXATION

No provision for Hong Kong Profits Tax is made in the financial statements as the Foundation is exempted from taxation under Section 88 of the Inland Revenue Ordinance.

5. GENERAL INFORMATION

Under the provision of the Foundation's article of association, every member, whilst he is member, or within one year after he ceases to be a member shall, in the event of the Foundation being wound up, contribute such amounts as may be required to meet the liabilities of the Foundation, but not exceeding HK\$100.

- Obtain an understanding of internal control relevant to the audit in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on the effectiveness of the Foundation's internal control.
- Evaluate the appropriateness of accounting policies used and the reasonableness of accounting estimates and related disclosures made by the directors.
- Conclude on the appropriateness of the director's use of the going concern basis of accounting and, based on the audit evidence obtained, whether a material uncertainty exists related events or conditions that may cast significant doubt on the Foundation's ability to continue as a going concern. If we conclude that a material uncertainty exists, we are required to draw attention in our auditor's report to the related disclosures in the financial statements or, if such disclosures are inadequate, to modify our opinion. Our conclusions are based on the audit evidence obtained up to the date of our audit's report. However, future events or conditions may cause the Foundation to cease to continue as a going concern.

We communicate with those charged with governance regarding, among other matters, the planned scope and timing of the audit and significant audit findings, including any significant deficiencies in internal control that we identify during our audit.

8. APPROVAL OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The financial statements were authorised for issue by the board of directors on 20 April 2023.
